

**NAME**

CURLOPT\_PROXYUSERPWD – user name and password to use for proxy authentication

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_PROXYUSERPWD, char *userpwd);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

Pass a char \* as parameter, which should be [user name]:[password] to use for the connection to the HTTP proxy. Both the name and the password will be URL decoded before use, so to include for example a colon in the user name you should encode it as %3A. (This is different to how *CURLOPT\_USERPWD(3)* is used - beware.)

Use *CURLOPT\_PROXYAUTH(3)* to specify the authentication method.

**DEFAULT**

This is NULL by default.

**PROTOCOLS**

Used with all protocols that can use a proxy

Returns CURLE\_OK if proxies are supported, CURLE\_UNKNOWN\_OPTION if not, or CURLE\_OUT\_OF\_MEMORY if there was insufficient heap space.
